ERASMUS MUNDUS- ACTION 1

Materials for Energy Conversion and Storage (MESC)

This European Master's course is designed to ensure intensive and innovative training on the synthesis, characterisation and industrial application of materials used in storage and conversion of energy, as well as to provide students with practical training in prestigious international research laboratories. The MESC consortium includes the following universities: Université de Paul Sabatier – Toulouse, Université de Picardie - Amiens and Université de Provence - Marseille (France), Universidad de Córdoba (Spain), Warsaw University of Technology (Poland), Xiamen University (China) and Drexel University (Philadelphia, USA).

Forensic Sciences

This unique Masters programme is designed to educate future European forensic scientists in the most up-to-date techniques. It brings together the expertise in forensic science of the University of Lincoln, the University of Córdoba (Spain) and the Instituto Superior de Ciências da Saúde Egas Moniz (Portugal).

ERASMUS MUNDUS-ACTION 2

TEMPO project

The TEMPO Project has been developed by a consortium of 20 universities: 9 European and 11 belonging to Central Asia. The project is coordinated by the Technical University of Lisbon (Portugal) in conjunction with the Donetsk National Technical University (Ukraine). The project aims to promote the exchange of knowledge among trans-European institutions of higher education in Europe and third countries in different areas of knowledge: Architecture, Chemistry, Biology, Chemical Engineering, Environmental Science and Management and Business Administration. The University of Alicante is involved in the area of architecture. The project has a budget of 3,508,975 euros and 212 mobility grants offered to undergraduates, Masters', PhD, Postdoctoral students and the staff of universities in the consortium.

EULAlinks project

EULAlinks is a partnership of 20 universities, 8 european and 12 from Latin America, jointly coordinated by the Humboldt Universität zu Berlin and the Universidad Autónoma de Chapingo (México). The overall objective of EULALinks is to deepen the existing cooperative relations under ALFA III SERIDAR Project "Rural Society, Economy and Natural Resources - Integrating competencies in Rural Development" of the School of Agricultural and Forest Engineering. This project aims to contribute to the creation of competence oriented and high-quality education in the Andean region and Mesoamerica, devoted to sustainable rural development, natural resources and agriculture value chains. The project has a budget of 3.317.025 euros and 135 mobility grants offered to undergraduates, Masters', PhD, Postdoctoral students and the staff from Latin American universities to the European universities belonging to the consortium.

Since 2004, the University Rovira i Virgili (URV) prepares an annual report on the visibility of the scientific output of its researchers with the help of international reference bibliographic databases included in the Web of Knowledge platform, a global benchmark for the study and dissemination of results of scientific activity of authors, institutions and countries, using indicators of quantity and quality of publications.
